Popular tradition holds that St. Anthony of Padua taught a prayer to a poor woman who sought help against the temptations of the devil. The Franciscan Pope, Sixtus V, had the prayer - also called "the motto of St. Anthony" - engraved into the base of the obelisk erected in St. Peter's Square in Rome. In the original Latin, the prayer says:

*Ecce Crucem Domini!
Fugite partes adversae!
Vicit Leo de tribu Juda,
Radix David! Alleluia!*



And translated, it reads

*Behold, the Cross of the Lord!
Begone, all evil powers!
The Lion of the tribe of Judah,
The Root of David, has conquered! Alleluia!*
